Visit to the N.S. SAVANNAH

On National Maritime Day in Baltimore, MD

Saturday, May 21, 2011 - 7:00 AM to 8:00 PM

Join the World Ship Society for a rare opportunity to visit this historic nuclear powered cargo-passenger liner. SAVANNAH will be participating in National Maritime Day, to be celebrated on May 21 from 10:00 AM until 4:00 PM. Other vessels participating in the celebration and most likely open for visitation will be the PRIDE OF BALTIMORE II, a tug, a fireboat, and Coast Guard and research vessels. Our modern, restroom-equipped Island Charter motorcoach will depart the west side of 9th Avenue between 41st and 42nd Street at 7:00 AM. We will be boarding the SAVANNAH upon arrival at approximately 11:00 AM. Once on board, the ship can be toured on a self-guided basis throughout the day. SAVANNAH's Promenade Deck is the ideal venue from which to observe the National Maritime Day Ceremony in the harbor, which commences at 11:45 AM and continues until about 12:30 PM. Immediately after the ceremony, we will be served a crab cake lunch on the Promenade Deck by the Chesapeake Chapter of the US Merchant Marine Academy Alumni Foundation. (Lunch vouchers will be handed out at embarkation.) At 2:00 PM, our group will attend a private presentation and Question & Answer session in the Officer's Mess, lasting between 45 minutes and one hour. Our motorcoach will depart at 4:00 PM sharp for the approximately four-hour return trip to New York. **You may also provide your own transportation and meet the World Ship Society group at the SAVANNAH.**

Fares: \$85.00 per member, including round-trip coach transportation, lunch and admission to the presentation and Question & Answer session on board the SAVANNAH. Guests are welcome for \$90.00 per person, but in fairness to our members, we reserve the right to limit their numbers. **\$40 per member or \$ 45 per guest without transportation.** Capacity is limited, so please reserve early.
